ANITA CHAUDHRY, J

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in case FIR No.194 dated 31.07.2017 registered under Sections 366-A/34 of IPC and Section 9 of Child Marriage Act (added later on) at Police Station Israna Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that according to the ossification test, age of the girl is 16-17 years and in the statement recorded under Section 164 Cr.P.C., she had stated that she had gone on her own and later on she was sent to the Nari Niketan and charge has been framed.

Learned State counsel informs that the girl is just 14 years old according to the School records and the statement of the victim is yet to be recorded.

The Statement of the girl would be necessary. The girl is presently residing with her parents and no longer in Nari Niketan.

No case for bail is made out at this state.

Petition is dismissed.
