RAMENDRA JAIN, J. (ORAL)

By this common judgment, I shall dispose of above-titled two petitions under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to petitioners, namely, Kuldeep Singh @ Keepu, Harbhagwan Singh @ Nikka, Karamjit Singh @ Nikka and Gurwinder Singh @ Deepu in a case arising from FIR No.101, dated 10.04.2018 registered under Sections 308/452/323/148/149/506/120-B IPC at Police Station Sadar Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

According to the prosecution, in the intervening evening of 09/10.04.2018, the complainant and one Rakesh Kumer (son-in-law of his maternal uncle) were given grievous multiple beatings by the petitioners by trespassing into premises of the complainant, where he is running tavern near a liquor shop, attracting aforementioned Sections.

Learned counsel for the petitioners *inter alia* contends that the

has already been filed in the Court. Conclusion of trial may take a long time.

No useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioners behind bars.

Considering overall facts and circumstances, but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petitions are allowed. Consequently, petitioners are ordered to be released on bail, on their furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
