The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.100 dated 23rd October, 2016, registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 471, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Sardulgarh, District Mansa.

2. The petitioner had allegedly applied for loan to the tune of Rs.49.20 lacs from the complainant-Bank which is stated to have been sanctioned obtained on the basis of forged and fictitious documents of title including *Jamabandi*.

3. After sanction of the said loan, various amounts from the loan account were withdrawn by the petitioner's brother-in-law Palwinder Singh and siphoned off to another joint account held by both of them. The cheques in question were admittedly signed only by the petitioner's brother-in-law-Palwinder Singh, who after prolonged detention was ordered to be released on bail by by this Court today vide separate order passed in **CRM-M No.732 of 2018**.

4. From the own statement made by the SP Investigation Mansa in his additional affidavit dated 1st May, 2018, all the siphoning after obtaining of the loan is attributed exclusively to the petitioner's brother-in-law.

5. In these circumstances, clearly there are no tangible grounds to warrant her detention particularly after co-accused Palwinder Singh has already been released on bail.

6. She is therefore ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer subject to the compliance of conditions under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
