The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.105 dated 17.06.2017 registered under Sections 376 & 120-B of IPC at Police Station City Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the victim is major and she knew that petitioner was married and this fact has been stated in the FIR and the allegations are that the petitioner was to get divorce from his wife and then marry her.

The petitioner is in custody since 03.01.2018. Statement of the victim has been recorded.

be released on bail on his furnishing surety and adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
