DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in compliance of order dated 31.7.2018, the petitioner has joined the investigation and the same has been affirmed by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Shishpal Singh. However, he submits that one more case under NDPS Act is pending against the petitioner.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is on bail in that case.

In view of the above, interim order dated 31.7.2018 passed in favour of the petitioner is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.

However, it is made clear that in case the petitioner is found to be involved in any other case of NDPS Act, State is at liberty to move an application for cancellation of bail.
