By way of filing the present petition, the petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in respect of a case registered against him vide FIR No.0315 dated 22.4.2018 under Section 379-A of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Gurgaon Sadar, District Gurugram.

The FIR had been lodged at the instance of Gopinath, who alleged that on 7.4.2018, when he was proceeding to his village on foot, then two boys came there on a motorcycle and the pillion rider snatched the mobile carried by the complainant. It is further stated therein that since both the said boys had muffled their faces, he could not recognize them.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the present petitioner is neither named in the FIR and that in fact the FIR in question was lodged after a delay of 15 days.

The learned Counsel for the State has, however, informed that the recovery of mobile phone has already been effected and even the challan has been presented in the Court.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case and also bearing in mind that the conclusion of trial will take long time, no useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner behind bars any longer. The present petition, as such, is accepted. The petitioner Rahul Soni is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

This petition stands disposed of accordingly.
