In the instant petition, petitioner has sought for anticipatory bail under the provision of Section 438 Cr.P.C in case FIR No.318 dated 18.06.2018 registered under Section 15 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Ratia District Fatehabad.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that petitioner's name is not reflected in the FIR. On the other hand while making second disclosure statement, petitioner's name has been cropped up in the matter. It is also submitted that petitioner is not involved in any other case.

3. The aforesaid submission is not disputed by the learned State counsel.

4. In view of the above facts and circumstances, petitioner is entitled for anticipatory bail.

5. Accordingly, petitioner is directed to join the investigation as and when called by the Investigating Officer. In the event of his arrest, he shall be released on pre-arrest anticipatory bail by the Investigating Officer on his furnishing bail bonds/sureties to his satisfaction subject to the

conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
