Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.45 dated 3.5.2018 under Sections 61/1/14 of Excise Act registered at Police Station Khanauri, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 12.7.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Jasvir Singh does not dispute the aforesaid fact and states that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required at this stage.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Since the petitioner has joined the investigation and as custodial interrogation is no more required, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 12.7.2018 is

made absolute.

However, if required, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
