DAYA CHAUDHARY, J.

The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to petitioner-Baldev Singh @ Bittu in case FIR No. 167 dated 4.8.2016 registered under Sections 307/393/394/324/323/420/465/467/468/471 read with Section 34 IPC and Sections 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act at Police Station City-I, Abohar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner alongwith co-accused have falsely been implicated in this case and he is behind the bars since 23.8.2016. Learned counsel further contends that co-accused of the petitioner, namely, Bhupinder Singh, Gurpreet Singh, Sat Pal Singh and Mahender Kumar have already been granted benefit of regular bail. The case of the petitioner is at par with aforesaid co-accused. Learned

counsel also contends that co-accused, namely, Baldev Singh approached this Court by way of filing Crl. Misc. No. M-13505 of 2017 and has been granted regular bail vide order dated 28.7.2017.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State has not opposed the factum of grant of regular bail to co-accused of the petitioner and his custody period .

By considering the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and also the fact that co-accused of the petitioner has already been granted benefit of regular bail, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner-Baldev Singh @ Bittu is directed to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
