Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.337 dated 23.12.2015 under Sections 323, 324, 506, 148 and 149 IPC (Section 326 IPC added subsequently) registered at Police Station Patti, District Tarn Taran.

Counsel for the petitioner states that apart from the fact that the other co-accused have been admitted on anticipatory bail by this Court, there is a delay of around 18 days in lodging the FIR. Since there is a previous enmity between the parties, the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perused the paper book.

A bare perusal of the FIR shows that the main injury has been attributed to the petitioner, who was armed with Kirpan and had given a blow with the same on the back side of head of the injured. The injury caused by the petitioner being grievous in nature, no ground for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition, being devoid of any merit, is dismissed.
