Present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for seeking bail pending trial in the FIR No. 216 dated 27.04.2018, under Sections 379, 419, 420, 467, 471, 201 IPC and 33 and 35 of Aadhar Act, registered at Police Station Ganaur(Sonepat).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has not committed any offence as alleged. In fact, the present FIR has been lodged by the complainant of the present FIR as a counter blast to another FIR which the present petitioner has lodged against him. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner is in custody since 10.05.2018. Learned counsel further submits that nothing incriminating has been recovered from the petitioner in the present case.

On the other hand, learned State counsel, being instructed by HC Jasbir Singh, submits that a laptop, printer and scanner have been recovered from the present petitioner. However, as an answer to the specific

query, counsel has not pointed out any material to connect the recovered laptop, printer and scanner to the present offence.

Learned counsel appearing for the complainant submitted that the petitioner has fabricated his own Aadhar Card, PAN Card and Driving Licence. Therefore, the petitioner should not be granted any concession of bail pending trial.

Be that as it may, the fact remains that, at the best, the petitioner is alleged to have fabricated his own Aadhar Card, own PAN Card and own Driving licence. It is not probable, prima facie, that the petitioner would forge his own documents when he was legally having the same.

In view of the above, but without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed. It is ordered that the petitioner shall be released on bail pending trial, on his furnishing bond/sureties to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
