In the present petition, petitioner seek anticipatory bail under the provision of Section 438 Cr.P.C. in FIR No.0055 dated 10.04.2017 under Sections 420, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station City I, Abohar District Fazilka.

2. This Court vide order dated 24.07.2018 had directed the petitioner to join investigation and in the event of her arrest, she was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Manjit Singh states that in pursuance to the order dated 24.07.2018 petitioner has joined investigation. Petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation.

4. In view of these factual aspect and circumstances, without expressing any opinion on the merits of case, the order dated 24.07.2018,

granting ad-interim bail to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

5. However, the petitioner shall not in any way indulge in any criminal activities and she shall also not influence the witnesses or otherwise interfere with the fair trial.

6. Accordingly, the petition stands allowed.
