The petitioner herein has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 695 dated 10.8.2017, under Sections 306/34 IPC registered at Police Station Jhajjar, District Jhajjar.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in this case and he is in custody since 4.10.2017. It is further submitted that material witnesses have been examined and argues that no offence under Section 306 IPC is made out against the petitioner since the deceased was residing in her parental house at the time she committed suicide. The trial is likely to take some time. No useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind bars till the conclusion of the trial. He prays that the petitioner be admitted to regular

bail.

Ms. Gaganpreet Kaur, learned AAG, Haryana opposes the bail application while submitting that the allegations levelled against the petitioner are of serious nature.

Without going into the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the statements of the material witnesses have been recorded and the trial is likely to take some time to conclude, the present petition is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
