The instant writ petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking a direction for the complaint dated 24.08.2017 which was followed by a representation dated 05.11.2017 against respondent Nos. 5 to 7 to be decided expeditiously.

It is contended that no legal proceedings have been initiated against respondent Nos. 5 o 7, who are the main persons involved. Learned counsel for the petitioner urges that the complaint/representation should be decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

At this stage, on the asking of the court Mr. V.G.Jauhar, Sr. DAG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents No. 1 to 3 and submits that official respondents will look into the matter and will

decide the representation of the petitioner within a period of six weeks, on receipt of certified copy of this order. Let sufficient number of copies of the paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day, failing which no action is called for.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the official respondents to decide the representation dated 07.11.2017 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of in the above-said terms.
