Petitioner-Khushi Ram has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.124 dated 02.04.2018, registered at Police Station Indri, District Karnal, under Section 174-A of IPC.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel has appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record, I find that vide order dated 03.01.2009 passed by learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Karnal, the present petitioner was declared proclaimed offender in case FIR No.106 dated 19.05.2003, under Section 392 of IPC, registered at Police Station

Indri. He is already in custody in the aforesaid FIR No.106 dated 19.05.2003. The present FIR is registered under Section 174-A of IPC.

The petitioner has been in custody since 02.04.2018. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping him in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, if his custody is not required in any other case and subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹30,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

However, nothing stated above shall constitute my opinion on merits of the case.
