This appeal has been filed against the award dated 08.09.2003 passed under Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Ambala awarding compensation of Rs. 34,052/- alongwith interest at the rate of 9% per annum on account of injuries suffered by the claimant in a vehicular accident.

This appeal has been filed by the owner and driver against that part of the award whereby the insurance company has been exonerated and the appellants have been foisted with the payment of Rs.34,000/- odd for injuries caused to respondent No.2. Since a very limited issue has been involved, further detailed reference to the facts is not required. Suffice it to
