This common order shall dispose of above noted two petitions
as they arise out of the same FIR.

These petitions have been filed under Section 439 of the Code
of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to petitioners Lakhwinder
Singh and Gurcharan Singh in case FIR No. 84 dated 05.05.2017, registered
under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the IPC at Police

Station Jandiala, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that the matter has been compromised between the parties and a petition bearing CRM-M-38795-2018 praying for quashing of the FIR in question, on the basis of the compromise, has already been filed which is pending for 30.01.2019 and as per the direction, issued in the said petition, the complainant as well as petitioners have already got recorded their statements before the trial Court regarding compromise. Photocopies of the statement of the complainant as well as that of the petitioners have been placed on record.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Joginder Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid facts and submitted that in the present FIR, Manish Chopra is the only complainant/victim.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case, considering the facts that the matter has been compromised between the parties and a petition for quashing of the FIR has already been filed; the instant petitions are allowed. Petitioners Lakhwinder Singh and Gurcharan Singh are ordered to be released on regular bail on their furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate concerned.
