The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.103 dated 06.07.2017, registered under Sections 494, 420, 376 IPC at Police Station Ladhuwal, District Ludhiana.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the main allegation against the petitioner is that he had married again and the wife could have filed a complaint and the offence is bailable. The counsel says that he is ready to settle with the complainant.

The counsel for the complainant urges that it is a case of cheating and the petitioner was earlier married and without disclosing the fact of the earlier marriage he married the complainant.

The State counsel informs that they have collected evidence and photographs of the earlier marriage of the petitioner.

The petitioner was already married and had a child, the police has collected the photographs of both the marriages, no case for anticipatory bail is made out.

The petition is dismissed.
