By this common order, this Court proposes to dispose of both the above mentioned petitions, as they arise out of the same set of facts.

The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the event of arrest in FIR No. 130 dated 07.07.2017 under Sections 498-A, 406 of the Indian

Penal Code registered at Police Station Civil Lines Batala, Police District Batala, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that during the pendency of the instant petition, the matter has been compromised between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court and on the direction of this Court, have joined the investigation. It is also contended that nothing is to be recovered from them .

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, submits that petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for the custodial interrogation.

In view of the facts that the petitioners are not required for custodial interrogation and have joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and interim orders granting bail to the petitioners are made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
