The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.12 dated 09.03.2018, under Sections 354-B, 452 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 3 and 4 of POCSO Act, registered at Police Station Kotfatta, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, has joined the investigation. It is also contended that nothing is to be recovered from him.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, submits that petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not

required for the custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
