Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he was regularly appearing before the Trial Court. However, on one occasion he could not appear on the date fixed because he had wrongly noted the date. Since the petitioner had not appeared before the Court on the date fixed, the Trial Court has cancelled the bail granted to the petitioner. Hence the petitioner apprehends his arrest. However learned counsel submits that the petitioner has no intention to flee from the course of justice. He intends to appear before the Court and he only prays for protection against the arrest.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Shri Hittan Nehra, Addl.AG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State. Copy of the petition has been supplied to him in Court.

Learned State counsel submits that he has no objection if the petitioner appears before the Trial Court and face the trial.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed. It is directed that in case the petitioner appears before the Trial Court within 10

days, then the petitioner shall be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds/surety to the satisfaction of the Trial Court.
