Pursuant to the order dated 24.01.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioner is stated to have joined investigation, though learned counsel for the State on instructions submits that she is not co-operating, in as much as she has not produced the original certificate, the photocopy of which was submitted by her at the time when she had applied for the post of an Anganwari Worker.

Mr.Brar, learned counsel for the petitioner, naturally contends that the petitioner has no such certificate with her .

That being so, and in any case the petitioner having applied for the said post, whether she was selected on the basis of the marks shown in the photocopy of her enhanced marks shown in the marks certificate annexed with the application or not, is something which would be gone into by the investigating agency, even if no original is eventually available, though of course the investigating agency would attempt to obtain the original if it's

available.

Consequently, without making any further comment on the merits of the case for or against the petitioner, which would be gone into by the investigating agency, and trial Court at the appropriate time when it comes to that stage, this petition is disposed of, with the order dated 24.01.2018 made absolute on the same terms and conditions, additionally adding that if the petitioner has any passport, she would immediately surrender it to the Investigating Officer.
