The present petition filed under Section 482 Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 and 2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondents No.3 to 7 as petitioners performed the marriage against their wish.

Reply of Suresh Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Hathin filed by learned State counsel is taken on record which transpires that the petitioners do not apprehend any threat from the hands of private respondents and they do not require any police protection.

In this view of the matter, the present petition has rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such.

However, in case any of the petitioners apprehend any threat to their limb, life and liberty in future, they may approach to the Superintendent of Police, Palwal and in that eventuality, be provided protection as prayed for.
