Learned counsel for the complainant has argued that what has been recorded in the order of this Court dated 24.01.2018 (as per the contention of learned counsel for the petitioner), actually does not give the true picture as regards the two enquiries/investigations conducted, inasmuch as, the first one was only a perfunctory one, with a very detailed inquiry/investigation now having been carried out after the complainant had approached this Court by way of CRM-M-27444 of 2017.

He therefore submits that as a matter of fact the deceased committed suicide on account of the petitioner harassing him to take her to his family so as for them to accept her as the wife of the deceased.

Learned counsel for the State, however, on instructions from ASI Parveen Kumar, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and presently her custodial interrogation is not required.

That being so, this petition is disposed, with the order dated 24.01.2018 being made absolute.

However, the Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur, is directed to ensure that a proper and fair investigation is conducted and if at any stage custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required due to her non-cooperation etc., naturally the investigating agency would be free to file an appropriate application for cancellation of bail.
