Petitioner has filed this petition seeking issuance of directions for protection of his life and liberty and his family members on apprehension of threat from respondents No.4 and 5. The petition is founded on the apprehension that respondents No.4 and 5 have some dispute with the petitioner and previously in 2016 some complaints were given by them against the petitioner. Annexure P-1 appended with the petition is the text messages of September, 2016.

A representation (Annexure P-2) for protection of life has been given to the Commissioner of Police, District Amritsar City on 30.04.2018. It is not in dispute that the petitioner is not in India and is residing in Australia.

Learned State counsel has filed short reply by way of affidavit of respondent No.2 along with Annexures R-1 and R-2. The same are taken

on record. In terms of the reply, the alleged representation (Annexure P-2) was never received in the office; besides, it is highlighted that respondent No.5 has got registered FIR against Sandeep Singh Bedi and Dilpreet Singh Bedi, brothers of the petitioner. The dispute is between brothers of the petitioner and respondent No.4.

In view of the above facts, particularly the fact that the petitioner is not residing in India, no case is made out for issuance of any direction.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
