The present petition filed under Section 482 Code of Criminal Procedure is for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners, with further direction to respondents No.4 to 6 not to interfere in the lives and liberty of the petitioners.

Learned counsel has placed on record the copy of affidavits and statements of the petitioners and and affidavit of respondent No.4 wherein it is specifically stated that now the matter has been settled amicably and the petitioners have no threat to their life and liberty from the hands of private respondents.

In this view of the matter, the present petition stands rendered infructuous and the same is dismissed as such.

However, in case the petitioners face any threat to their limb, life and liberty in future from the hands of private respondents, in that eventuality, they can approach to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala.
