The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in the event of arrest in FIR No. 66 dated 10.05.2018 under Sections 323, 324, 452, 427, 506, 148, 149, 379 and later on added Section 354 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sadar, district Hoshiarpur .

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioners are falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, have joined the proceedings. It is also contended that nothing is to be recovered from them.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating

Officer, submits that petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for the custodial interrogation

In view of the facts that in compliance to the order dated 13.07.2018, the petitioners have joined the proceedings and furnished their bail bonds, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 13.07.2018 granting interim protection to the petitioners is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
