FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

As is submitted by the private parties through their respective counsel that their statements regarding compromise have been got recorded before the Court below on 18.07.2018 but in spite of specific orders of this Court dated 13.07.2018 and 17.09.2018 no such report has been received by this Court. Though, the learned State counsel has placed on record attested copy of an order dated 18.07.2018 of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Faridabad along with copies of statements of complainant Ms.Poonam Ahuja and accused Anil Arora alias Raju wherein the parties have shown their resolve to end their dispute as they have effected a compromise in this case got registered by way of FIR No.670 dated 10.11.2017 under Sections 354-A/506 IPC at Police Station

Sanjay Gandhi Memorial Nagar, District Faridabad. The parties in their stand taken before this Court have vouched for this compromise which is placed on record as (Annexure P1) and have submitted that the matter between them stands resolved and the FIR in question and all proceedings arising therefrom may be quashed.

In the light of the stand of both the sides together with the fact that the offences for which the accused has been hauled up are not of serious nature and that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh v. State of Punjab and another**' 2012(4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No.670 dated 10.11.2017 under Sections 354-A/506 IPC at Police Station Sanjay Gandhi Memorial Nagar, District Faridabad and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioner are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
