Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to respondent(s) to fairly, properly and impartially investigate FIR No. 0196 dated 02.08.2016.

Reply by way of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Ambala Cantt, District Ambala, on behalf of respondents No. 1 and 2 has already been filed and as per the same, untrace report was prepared on 20.06.2017 and the same is pending with the Superintendent of Police for approval.

It is further stated that in case, any clue qua causing injury to the petitioner is found, then action will be taken as per rules after conducting further investigation in the case.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kulbir Singh, further submits that untrace report will be submitted before the trial Court/Illaqa Magistrate within a period of two months from today.
