The present petition filed under Section 482 Code of Criminal Procedure is for issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to protect the lives and personal liberty of the petitioners, with further direction to respondents No.4 to 9 not to interfere in the personal lives and liberty of the petitioners.

Report from the Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa received which transpires that the matter has been amicably settled and the petitioners do not require any police protection.

Therefore the present petition has rendered infructuous and the same is dismissed as such.

However, in case the petitioners are required any threat to their limb, life and liberty in future, they may approach to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa and in that eventuality, they be provided protection.
