1. Through this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for quashing FIR No. 365 dated 17.09.2015 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC at Police Station, Sector 36, Chandigarh and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2) effected between the parties.

2. Vide order dated 04.08.2017, the parties were directed to appear before the trial Court, to get their statements recorded with regard to the compromise with a direction to the trial Court, to furnish a report qua veracity of the compromise.

3. Consequently, the parties appeared before the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Chandigarh and got recorded their statements qua compromise. Report from the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Chandigarh, vide letter No. 551 dated 20.09.2017, duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Chandigarh vide Endst. No. DSJ-EC-2017/11607,

Dated 20.09.2017 has been received. According to the report of the learned

Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Chandigarh, the compromise is genuine and the parties have entered into the same voluntarily, without any undue influence, pressure and coercion from any side.

4. In view of the totality of the facts and circumstances of the case and considering the fact that the compromise will bring harmony in relations between the parties, this petition is allowed and the aforesaid FIR No. 365 dated 17.09.2015 (Annexure P-1) and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, qua the petitioner is quashed, subject to payment of costs of ₹10,000/-, out of which ₹6,000/- shall be deposited with the Punjab State Legal Services Authority and ₹4,000/- with the Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana, within two weeks from today, failing which this petition shall be deemed to have been dismissed.
