FATEH DEEP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners Durga Dass and Bittu alias Santokh Ram in case registered by way of FIR No.23 dated 04.02.2018 at Police Station City Phagwara, District Kapurthala under Sections 323, 452, 427, 506, 148, 149 and 354 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the orders of interim bail dated 26.07.2018 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined investigations which is not controverted by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sukhwinder Singh, Police Station City Phagwara, who submits that the petitioners are no longer required for further investigation and nothing

remains to be recovered from them and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

In view of what has been stated above and in the light of orders passed earlier, the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 26.07.2018 is made absolute, however, they shall abide by the conditions specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, they will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
