Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.81 dated 25.04.2018 registered under Sections 379-B, 392, 379, 380, 482 of IPC at Police Station Adampur, District Jalandhar.

Power of attorney filed on behalf of petitioner in court today, is taken on record.

Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate of the petitioner in court today, which is taken on record.

On 20.07.2018, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Custody certificate filed in Court today is taken on record.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kashmir Singh, submits that the petitioner is involved in five more cases i.e 1. FIR No.46 dated 05.06.2014, under Section 379 IPC, Police Station Bahiram Distt. SBS

Nagar, 2. FIR No. 203 dated 14.07.2014 under Sections 379 and 411 IPC Police Station Mukerian, District Jalandhar, 3. FIR no.31 dated 16.02.2015 under Sections 379 and 411 IPC, Police Station Rama Mandi, District Jalandhar(City) 4. FIR No.33 dated 17.02.2015, under Sections 223 and 224 IPC, Police Station Rama Mandi Distt. Jalandhar (City) and 5. FIR no. 78 dated 17.04.2018 under Section 458, 457, 380 and 342 IPC Police Station Adampur Distt. Jalandhar.

Counsel for the petitioner seeks time to verify the said fact.

On his request, adjourned to 21.09.2018.”

Considering the fact that number of cases are registered against the petitioner, no case for grant of regular bail to the petitioner is made out.

Dismissed.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has been acquitted in four cases.

In case it is found that the petitioner has been acquitted in the aforesaid cases, he is at liberty to seek recall of this order.
