Present petition has been filed under Section 407 Cr.P.C. read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for transfer of the trial of FIR No.490 dated 26.12.2015, under Sections 420, 177 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City Rewari, District Rewari along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, titled as '**State Versus Vikramjit Singh**', pending in the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Rewari to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Bathinda.

In pursuance of the notice of motion, issued by this Court, respondent No.2-Vikramjeet Singh, represented by Mr. Achin Gupta, Advocate and respondent No.3-Baby are present in the Court. Respondent No.3-Baby has produced her original Aadhaar Card. Photocopy of the same is retained and marked as 'X'.

Since both the respondents have no objection in case the trial is transferred to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Bathinda.
