Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438

Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.27 dated 20.02.2016, registered under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station Civil Lines, District Bathinda.

Learned State counsel has submitted that on the sale deed, photographs and the signatures of the petitioner are very much there but she signed as Harjinder Kaur and not as Charanjeet Kaur. She impersonated herself as Harjinder Kaur.

It is totally a case of civil nature and also of impersonation.

To the mind of this Court, the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is required. As such, she is not entitled to the benefit of anticipatory bail.

Accordingly, the instant petition stands dismissed.
