In view of submission of learned counsel for the petitioner but without expressing any opinion on merits, this petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga to look into the submission put forth by the petitioner and take appropriate action in accordance with law and dispose of the representation (Annexure P-3) expeditiously, preferably within four months on receipt of copy of this order.

However, it is made clear that the above order will not be interpreted as providing protection to the petitioner from any legal action taken in any civil, criminal or any other proceedings initiated/pending against him in accordance with law.
