Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.13 dated 24.01.2018 under Sections 379A, 34 and Section 411 IPC (added subsequently) registered at Police Station GRP, Chandigarh, District GRP Ambala Cantt.

Vide order dated 30.10.2018, following order was passed by this Court:

“No one is present on behalf of the petitioners. Similarly, on the earlier dates of hearing i.e. 13.08.2018 and 07.09.2018, none had appeared on behalf of the petitioners.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Ajay Kumar, states that during pendency of the present petition, the

petitioners had approached before the trial Court and succeeded in getting the relief of regular bail.

In paragraph No.9 of this petition, the petitioners have mentioned that no such or similar petition is pending in the Sessions Court, Panchkula or any other Court of law at the time of filing of this petition.

Therefore, the factum of a parallel petition has not been brought to the notice of this Court.

Let a show cause notice be issued to the petitioners as to why their bail be not cancelled.

Adjourned to 30.11.2018.”

Petitioners are present in person.

At this stage, counsel for the petitioners seeks withdrawal of this petition.

Though withdrawal of the present petition cannot be permitted on account of withholding of information by the petitioners, however, in the interest of justice, petitioners are permitted to withdraw the present petition subject to payment of costs.

Dismissed as withdrawn subject to payment of costs of Rs.2,500/- to be deposited in the account of the Punjab and Haryana High Court Bar Association, Chandigarh.
