By way of the present petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of directions to respondent Nos. 1 and 2 to consider and promote the petitioner as Accountant from the due date with a further direction to grant all the consequential benefits arising therefrom such a fixation of pay, arrears etc.

Learned counsel for respondent Nos. 1 and 2 refers to order dated 11.07.2005, wherein the petitioner had confined his claim of consideration for promotion on the post of Accountant which had fallen vacant on 30.06.2005 and will contest his claim with regard to retrospective promotion after the decision of CWP-6772-1990. He further states that as CWP-6772-1190 has been dismissed for non-prosecution, vide order dated 28.04.2010 and the petitioner has been given notional

promotion to the post of Accountant w.e.f 01.07.2008 and is drawing pension as such.
