The custody certificate of the petitioner has been filed in Court today by learned State counsel, which is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody for more than 04 months now with only the 'challan' presented against him, and as regards the allegation against him, it is based on the sole statement of a police official.

Learned counsel for the State, on query, submits that there are two other cases pending against the petitioner, one for offences punishable under Sections 328 and 379 IPC and the other for offences punishable under Sections 457 and 380 IPC.

It is submitted that the charge has been framed but no witness has been examined so far.

Keeping in view the fact that the trial is likely to take long as yet, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case either for or against

the petitioner, the petition is allowed. The petitioner shall be admitted to bail upon his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
