Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.94 dated 03.03.2017 under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 of IPC and Section 13 of Punjab Prevention of Human Smuggling Act, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Amritsar, District Amritsar.

On 20.07.2018, this Court had issued notice to the respondent on the submissions made by the counsel for the petitioner that the matter has been compromised with the complainant.

At this stage, Mr.Vinod Kumar Kaushal, Advocate, has put in appearance on behalf of complainant and filed memorandum of appearance, which is taken on record. He states that no compromise has been arrived at.
