This petition has been filed seeking a direction to respondent Nos. 1 to 4 to not harass and humiliate the petitioners.

It is mentioned that the petitioners are facing harassment at the hands of respondent Nos. 1 to 4 on account of being summoned in a complaint filed by respondent No. 5, though, respondent No. 5 has already suffered a statement before the Women Cell that she does not wish to pursue her complaint against the petitioners.

It is noticed that none had appeared on behalf of the petitioners on the last two occasions. Notice issued to respondent No. 5 has been received back unserved with the report that she left the given address 4-5 years ago.

Learned counsel for the State was directed to verify whether any statement was suffered by respondent No. 5 before the Women Cell to the effect that she did not wish to pursue her complaint and wishes to reside with her husband.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Chand

Ram, informs that respondent No. 5 had earlier suffered a statement on 27.06.2017 that she did not wish to pursue her complaint against the petitioners. Another complaint was filed by her on 04.08.2017 however she refused to suffer any statement in respect to her allegations, when called upon by the investigating agency. The matter was duly closed on 03.11.2017.

It appears that petitioners are also not interested in pursuing the matter.

Accordingly, this petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
