Through this application prayer has been made for correction of typographical error in the name of the complainant-respondent No.2 in the memo of parties in CRM-M-2953 of 2018, which has wrongly been typed as Manke Mukesh Kumar son of Sh. Duli Chand instead of Mukesh Kumar son of Sh. Dule Chand.

Heard.

Application is allowed as prayed for. Name of respondent No.2 be read as Mukesh Kumar son of Sh. Dule Chand in place of Manke Mukesh Kumar son of Sh. Duli Chand in the memo of parties.

Main Case

Prayer in the instant petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been made for quashing FIR No.765 dated 06.10.2017 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 323, 365, 379-B and 34 IPC at Police Station Mujessar,

District Faridabad, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

2. Pursuant to order dated 02.08.2018 of this Court, the parties appeared before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate on 29.08.2018 to get their statements recorded. Learned Additional District and Sessions Judge, Faridabad has submitted his report vide letter bearing No.749, dated 12.09.2018 duly forwarded by learned District and Sessions Judge, Faridabad, vide letter No.23937 dated 18.09.2018.
3. According to the report, learned Additional District and Sessions Judge, Faridabad, is satisfied that compromise entered into between the parties is genuine, voluntary, without any coercion or undue influence with their free will.
4. Considering the report of learned Additional District and Sessions Judge, Faridabad, dated 12.09.2018 and the fact that the compromise will bring peace and harmony in relations between the parties, FIR No.765 dated 06.10.2017 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 323, 365, 379-B and 34 IPC at Police Station Mujessar, District Faridabad, is quashed, subject to payment of costs of ₹10,000/-, out of which ₹6,000/- shall be deposited with the Haryana State Legal Services Authority and ₹4,000/- with the Bar Council of Punjab and Haryana High Court.
5. Petition is disposed of accordingly.
6. List on 14.11.2018, for production of receipt with regard to deposit of aforesaid costs.
