This order shall dispose of three petitions i.e. CRM-M-
Nos.29533, 30391 and 31356 of 2018, as the same have arisen out of
common FIR and common relief has been claimed in all these petitions.

However, for brevity facts are being noticed from CRM-M-29533-2018.

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.205 dated 11.04.2018 under Section 306 IPC registered at Police Station Quilla Panipat, District Panipat.

As per the FIR, the deceased Rajpal, father of the complainant, used to manufacture and supply the school bags to various book sellers. The allegation against the petitioners is that they have not made the payment of the bags so supplied to them by the deceased. Though the deceased had asked many times to release his payment but no such payment was made despite giving assurances. On account of non-payment of money against the bags so supplied, deceased Rajpal committed suicide.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners have joined the investigation and in fact, the matter has otherwise been compromised between the parties during the pendency of the present petitions.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Hawa Singh, does not dispute the aforesaid facts.

Be that as it may, considering the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 17.07.2018 is made absolute.
