Petitioner Sonu has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.114 dated 20.04.2017, registered at Police Station Sadar Jind, District Jind, under Sections 147/148/149/307/506 of Indian Penal Code and under Sections 25/54/59 of Arms Act.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

As per the prosecution version, the present petitioner has been named in the FIR. He was armed with a country-made pistol and fired from it. The shot did not hit anybody. It is a no injury case.

The petitioner has been in custody since 29.09.2017. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial

custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
