Petitioner-Saleem has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.117 dated 01.07.2018, registered at Police Station Khizrabad, Yamuna Nagar, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324, 326, 452 506 of Indian Penal Code.

Notice of motion has been issued. Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for the complainant appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

From the record I find that though the present petitioner has been named in the FIR, but no injury has been attributed to him. The grievous injury is only on the little finger.

The petitioner has been in custody since 01.07.2018. He is not

custody. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.25,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
