The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.82 dated 12.11.2017, registered at Police Station Tibber, District Gurdaspur, under Sections 420, 120-B IPC.

The allegations in the FIR are that the petitioner conspired with her children and some others to defraud the complainant of her property. The property is the only residential house of the complainant at Patiala and she has inherited it from her parents. Both the parents are now deceased and it appears to be a case where a single lady is being de-frauded of her property by her close relatives.

In view of the above, the petitioner does not deserve the concession of anticipatory bail.

The petition is dismissed, accordingly.
