Prayer in this petition is for issuance of direction to respondent No.4 to protect the life, liberty and property of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.6 and 7.

Reply by way of affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division, Sunam on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 has been filed and as per this affidavit, on complaint made by respondent No.6-Vinarjit Singh against the petitioners, namely, Ashok Kumar and Rishu Kumar, the allegations are of cheating of Rs.33,74,880/-. An enquiry was conducted by DSP, Sub-Division Sunam, District Sangrur and on the basis of the enquiry, FIR No. 215, dated 07.12.2015 under Section 420, 406 of IPC at Police Station City, Sunam has been registered against the petitioners and thereafter, the petitioners in compliance of the order dated 14.12.2015

passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Sangrur granting interim bail to them have joined the investigation and case is still under investigation.

Since the police authorities are acting in accordance with law and the petitioners have been nominated as accused persons in the aforesaid FIR, this petition is dismissed as infructuous.
