GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.197 dated 12.10.2017 under Sections 323, 324, 341, 427, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar and proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.

Vide order dated 18.07.2018 the parties had been directed to

appear before the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate so as to get the statements recorded with regard to the genuineness of the compromise.

Report of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar has been received to the effect that apart from the statements of the petitioner/accused, the statement of the complainant-Lovepreet Singh @ Lovejeet Singh has also been recorded who has specifically stated that he has compromised the matter with the accused and he does not want to proceed with the present case against the accused and he has no objection, in case, FIR is quashed. Learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Amritsar has specifically opined that the compromise is genuine and has been effected voluntarily without there being any undue influence or coercion.

In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the petition is allowed and FIR No.197 dated 12.10.2017 under Sections 323, 324, 341, 427, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar and all the consequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
