The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 482 Cr.P.C for quashing of FIR No.162 dated 15.12.2011 under Sections 420, 406, 506, 34 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Samana, District Patiala on the basis of compromise/ settlement agreement dated 07.05.2014 (Annexure P.2).

A perusal of the order-sheet of the file shows that the parties were directed to get their statements recorded before the trial Court qua the compromise stated to have been arrived at between them.

The Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Samana has sent his report dated 02.03.2015 that the compromise arrived at between the parties appears to be voluntary without any pressure.

However, there is one order placed on file as well, in which some amounts were required to be paid by the petitioners. It appears that the compromise stated to have been arrived at between the parties has not fully matured.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. The office note shows that keeping in view the fact that the proceedings have

been stayed in this case for the past seven years, counsel for the parties were duly informed by the Registry regarding the date of hearing fixed for today. However, none of them have chosen to appear and to apprise the Court regarding the fate of the said compromise.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to quash the case/ FIR on the basis of compromise.

Dismissed.
