On 08.08.2017, notice of motion was issued and interim protection was granted to the petitioner on the ground that injury falling under the ambit of grievous hurt was attributed to co-accused Harpreet Singh @ Happy. Thereafter, the said order was made to continue.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an author of simple injury which was declared to be simple in nature. He further submitted that in compliance of the order dated 08.08.2017, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The aforesaid facts have not been disputed by the

learned State counsel on instructions from HC Ranjit Singh.

However, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the complainant opposed the prayer made by the petitioner for grant of anticipatory bail.

After hearing, learned counsel for the parties, I deem it appropriate to confirm the interim order dated 08.08.2017. Ordered accordingly. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when directed to do so.

Petition stands disposed of.
